What is the difference between parental involvement and parental engagement:

Although involvement in school activities is beneficial in many ways ... parents supporting their child's learning at home has a bigger impact on outcomes than participation in school activities.

Education Capital: Progressing Parental Engagement (ACT 2014)

Parent involvement refers to parent participation in formal and informal activities at the school such as attending parent group meetings, running a stall at the school fête or volunteering at the canteen.

Parental engagement refers to the broader role parents play in supporting their child's learning. Parental engagement recognises the important role that both parents and teachers play in children's learning and development.
